ARTICLE 1 – Institution

ELIGIBILITY REQUIREMENTS

Applicants with the following qualifications can apply for the Postgraduate Course:

- > All Bachelor Degree attained in accordance with D.M. no. 270 of 22nd October 2004;
- All Bachelor Degree attained in accordance with D.M. no. 509 of 3rd November 1999;
- All Degrees attained in accordance with the rules previously in force under Ministerial Decree (DM) no. 509 of 3rd November 1999.
- High-School Diploma with proven experience in the sector, previous evaluation of the curriculum vitae by the Selection Board.
- All equivalent qualifications issued abroad, recognized as suitable by the Course Scientific Committee for the limited purpose of enrolment in the course, in accordance with the regulations in force.

Deadline for submission of applications is October the 18th, 2024 at 1.00 p.m.

Professional profile the course intends to provide:

The course aims to provide theoretical and practical knowledge in the field of the technology of sound engineering, with reference to the state of the art in the sector.

Educational objectives:

The objective of the course is to provide fundamental theoretical knowledge for the comprehension, analysis and design of modern sound diffusion systems.

Such knowledge ranges from the fundamental principles of acoustics, to transducers and speakers, electronic amplifying systems and digital sound filtering, and also soundproofing systems.

The teaching include:

- E-leaning lessons;
- Lecture and two/three practical experience on lab during Acoustic, Electroacoustic, Electronics and Sound System modules.
- The teaching is organized into the four didactic modules described below, which include both theoretical lessons (the greater part of the course) and practical experience:

1) Acoustics

<u>Introduction to acoustics:</u> the nature of the sound, its generation, quantity, propagation, punctiform sources and cylindrical sources;

<u>Psychoacoustics:</u> sound levels and perception of sound, spectral composition, normal audiogram and weighting curves.

<u>Acoustics of internal environment:</u> reflection, transmission and absorption, temporal evolution of sound, reverberation, reverberation field and time (RT)

<u>Acoustic of open spaces:</u> effects of temperature, humidity and wind, diffraction, masking, acoustic air absorption.

2) Electroacoustics

<u>Transducers</u>: typology, static and dynamic characteristics; model for designing (Thiele-Small) and for the simulation of electro-mechanical properties; compression drivers and horn loading.

Loudspeaker system: typology, operation, materials and technology; concepts of bands and crossovers, types of cabinet, directivity (dispersion curve) and characteristics of radiation

3) Electronics

Introductory concepts: electronic technology and devices (MOSFET, IGBT, SiC diode); signal amplifiers: topologies, efficiency, distortion, matching, feedback, stability and compensation.

D class Power amplifiers: topology, losses, modulation strategy and indexes of performance.

<u>Digital signal processing</u>: DSP: general characteristics, operation, processing and standby time basic and planning algorithms; digital filters (FIR-IIR); special filters for audio applications;

4) Sound systems

Speakers: audio chain, the speaker and amplifier system (audio processor and control)

<u>Sound reinforcement system:</u> multiband mixers; subwoofers, line arrays, digital steering arrays. Simulation software, models of mixers; radiation balloons

<u>Design of sound reinforcement system</u>: choice of mixers and their insertion based on the requirements of power and directivity; dimensioning and installation; design of a sound system using acoustic simulation.

Duration and organization of the course:

E-learning lessons will be available from the November 3rd 2024.

Lessons and practical experience will be held for the 75% in distance learning, in collaboration with University E-learning Center (CEA). The remaining 25% of the lessons and exercises will be delivered in the presence and will be concentrated in the week of March 24-28, 2025.

The Lessons will be held by RCF Audio Academy, Via Giovanni Bovio 2/I, Reggio Emilia (RE) and Department of Science and Methods of Enginering

The course will conclude with a final test, consisting of a written examination on March 28th,2025 based on the technical contents of the course.

Enrolment fee: one instalment of €850,00 payable upon enrolment.

Total hours: 375 hours (of which 120 hours are lectures and alternative teaching and 255 are individual study).

CFU (University Credits): 15

Teaching staff: The teaching staff consists of members of the University of Modena and Reggio Emilia, University of Parma and well-reputed experts in sector.

ARTICLE 2 – Admission Requirements

Candidates in possession of an eligible qualification obtained in Italy specified in article 1 of this Call for Applications or holding equivalent academic qualifications from foreign universities may participate in the admission test, without limit as to age or citizenship.



Candidates who have an Italian qualification must must self-certify possession of the qualification required for access using form <u>Annex A</u>. The self-certification must be attached the to the online application form in accordance to the procedure provided at Article 3.

Candidates who have a foreign qualification must provide valid documents for verification (Degree certificate with official grades, or a description of the Degree with a list of exams successfully taken. Refer to <u>Annex B</u> of this Call) to the Department of Sciences and Methods for Engineering (Via Amendola 2, Padiglione Morselli – 42122 Reggio Emilia RE), attaching the document to the application form in accordance to the procedure provided at Article 3.

Italian and foreign citizens in possession of a foreign academic qualification must, by deadline provided for enrolment set out by the regulations in force on the subject of enrolment of foreign students, present the following documentation:

- Academic qualification, translated and legalized by the Italian diplomatic mission (Embassy or Consulate) in the country in which the same was obtained.
- "Statement of Validity" ("dichiarazione di valore in loco") obtained from the same mission.

For further information refer to <u>www.miur.it</u> – University – Students – Foreign Students. The information provided by Candidates will be carefully checked by the competent offices for the purpose of verification of correctness.

Candidates are admitted to the selection procedure subject to verification of the aforementioned requirements.

ARTICLE 3 – Admission and Registration

Applications for admission to the selection procedure and any other attachments (certificates and documents considered useful for the purposes of the selection process) must be submitted to this Administration, under penalty of exclusion, within the <u>final deadline date stated in Article</u> 1 (18th October 2024 at 1.00 p.m), solely using the following <u>online procedure:</u>

Then click on "Student Area", follow "Admission" – "Enrolment" – "Postgraduate Degrees".

All degrees and documents necessary for the selection process must be attached only in electronic format (Pdf or RTF) with a maximum size of 20 MB. Attachments larger than 20 MB will be divided into several parts.

The application for admission requires the payment of the <u>non-refundable \in 41.00 administrative</u> service fee (including the \in 25.00 administrative service fee and the \in 16.00 stamp duty).

After filling in the application form, go to www.esse3.unimore.it: once you have logged in, go to the Fees heading to view the amounts due to make the payment of the required contributions, exclusively through the **pagoPA** circuit.

The payment methods are indicated at http://www.unimore.it/ammissione/pagamenti.html.

Payment of the fee must be done no later than the deadline date stated in Art.1.

Warning! According to the indications of "AgID" (Agenzia per l'Italia digitale), the payment transaction could be executed by the "PSP" Payment Service Provider the day after the request made by the payer, precluding admission.

The application form is meant fairly presented only with the rescue data ("Save the data") made after the "explicit confirmation of the validity of the application" given by the candidate at the end of the



procedure mentioned above (see "Guide to the application for admission" published on the University's website at https://www.unimore.it/sites/default/files/2023-11/guida_ammissione_master.pdf).

Please note, before officially submitting your application after the data will be saved ("Save Data") following the "explicit confirmation of the validity of the application", students will be able to modify data before the deadline date (consult the Guide to the application for admission")

Emailing or faxing submissions of the application and its attachments are not permitted and will not be accepted.

Applications submitted in the appropriate procedure described above, will be considered to be on time only if they reach the Administration before the final deadline. Applications received after the deadline or received by means other than those listed above will not be considered.

During the online registration, candidates shall declare, under their own responsibility:

- c. Residential address; telephone/mobile number; email address (for the purposes of the admission;
- d. Fiscal code (if already in possession of one). Those without a Fiscal code will have to obtain one automatically generated for them by the system);
- e. Applicant's citizenship information;
- f. Declare to be in possession of the qualification required for admission to the program (Art. 1 "Access Requirements" of the Call), or an equivalent academic qualification from a foreign university;
- g. Exact name of the Master to which the candidate wants to be registered for;
- h. Curriculum vitae;
- i. Other title/degree certificates and any other documents;
- j. In the case of candidates with disabilities, in accordance with Law no. 104 of February 5, 1992, any kind of help necessary to support the examination.

By submitting the application for admission, the candidate agrees to:

- 1. Promptly communicate any change of address or telephone number;
- Communicate their degree(s), with the list of exams taken, along with an Italian translation, legalization and "Statement of Validity" obtained by the Italian Consular in the territorial jurisdiction, subject to the existing rules on the admission of foreign students to degree courses at Italian universities, by the registration deadline. (For Italian or foreign citizen in possession of a foreign degree).

The exclusion of candidacy can be communicated to the candidate at any time due to lack of admission requirements. Applications submitted or received after the deadline, or in ways other than those specified in this Call will not be taken under consideration. The Administration assumes no responsibility in cases of loss communications due to incorrect address or failure or delay in notifying a change in contact details, technical errors or negligence of third parties, unforeseeable circumstances or force majeure. In addition, the Administration assumes no responsibility in the event of non-receipt of documents from third party negligence, as well as in the event of errors by the candidate in inserting attached files and/or in any case of network failure.

Titles and Documents:

For online registration procedure, candidates must attach the following with the application form:



- Self-certification of the access requirement (for candidates holding a degree obtained in Italy) under art. 46 and 47 of DPR 445/2000 using Annex A (found at the end of this Call);
- Degree certificate with exams or description of the degree with a list of exams (for candidates holding a foreign degree). Refer to Annex B (found at the end of this Call).
- Titles and documents necessary for the assessment and corresponding list;
- Curriculum vitae in English;
- Copy of valid identification (ID card or Passport);

In compliance with Article 15 of the Law dated November 12 2011, n. 183 it is stated that the certificates issued by the public administration related to countries, personal qualities and facts are valid and usable only in relations between private institutions/companies. When dealing with public administration and providers of public services certificates and acts of notoriety are always replaced by the statements referred to in Articles 46 and 47.

The certificates issued by the competent authorities of the State of which the foreign candidate is a citizen, must comply with the provisions in force in those countries and furthermore must be translated and legalized by the competent Italian consular authorities.

Documents written in a foreign language must be accompanied by a translation in Italian, certified true to the original text prepared by the competent Italian diplomatic or consular or by an official translator.

ARTICLE 4 – Production and approval of the list of qualified candidates

The selection procedures and schedule of examinations are indicated in Art. 1.

At the end of the selection process, the Commission will draw up the list of qualified candidates, based on the total score awarded to each candidate.

ARTICLE 5 – Enrolment of successful candidates

<u>Within a maximum of seven days</u> starting on the day following the publication of the list on the website of the University, candidates admitted according to the list of qualifying students shall enroll in the Master only in accordance with the following procedure:

Candidates must login into the University website: <u>http://www.esse3.unimore.it/Home.do</u> 'Login' and insert the username and password that were assigned to them at the time of registration for the admission phase. Those students already in possession of a username and password from the University of Modena and Reggio Emilia have to use them.

Candidates have to follow the instructions outlined in the Student Section: "Registration" - "Enrollment in courses with planned access ranking" (if you don't have username and password, send an e-mail to webhelp@unimore.it for assistance);

Candidates admitted, according to the list of qualifying students, must confirm the information entered at the time of submission of the application and must print the following documents:

- a) Course registration form;
- b) Photocopy of the payment receipt for the enrolment fee referred to in Art .1.

The payment of the due amounts must be made only through the PagoPA circuit which allows online payment by choosing your Payment Service Provider - PSP. Upon payment confirmation, an email will be sent to the personal mailbox entered during registration, or to the University mailbox if already activated. From your personal Esse3 page, under the item "Taxes", it will be possible to print the payment receipt.

It should be noted that the amount of commissions may vary depending on the selected PSP.



Please note that payment of the first installment does not constitute as registration for the Master's.

Registration is deemed to be completed when payment and all documents are delivered to the Department of Sciences and Methods for Engineering, Via Amendola 2 – Pad. Morselli 42122 Reggio Emilia (RE) no later than 7 days after the publication of the final list of qualifying candidates; applications received after such date will not be accepted. Applications may be send by <u>registered letter with receipt</u>, by DHL (please note that the relevant date will be the date of receipt of the package by the Department and not the shipment date) or by e-mail to <u>didattica.dismi@unimore.it</u> (indicate as object "Registration CDP – Sound Engineering) The following documents are to be sent:

- Registration form, printed from the Student Online system and duly completed and signed;
- Self-certification of the access requirement under Art.46 and 47 of DPR 445/2000 using Annex A (found at the end of the Call) for candidates holding a degree obtained in Italy;
- Degree certificate with exams or description of the degree with a list of exams (for Candidates holding a foreign degree), if necessary using Annex B (found at the end of this Call).
- Receipt of payment of the enrolment fee;
- Signed (front and back) photocopy of a valid identification document.

Applications made with incomplete documentation will not be accepted.

The University of Modena and Reggio Emilia will not be liable for any delays in delivery, lost mail or incomplete documentation.

Italian or foreign candidates who have a foreign qualification must provide the Department of Sciences and Methods for Engineering by e-mail to <u>didattica.dismi@unimore.it</u> (indicate as object "Registration CDP – Sound Engineering) the degree certificate with exams along with an Italian translation, legalization and "Statement of Validity" obtained by the Italian consular in the territorial jurisdiction.

Upon arrival into Italy, foreign citizens who are not yet in possession of the Fiscal Code must apply to the "Agenzia delle Entrate" (Via Paolo Borsellino 32, 42124 Reggio Emilia) and forward a copy of the issued card within <u>30 days</u> of the start of the Course to the Department of Sciences and Methods for Engineering, Via Amendola 2 – Pad. Buccola 42122 Reggio Emilia (RE) by e-mail: <u>didattica.dismi@unimore.it</u>.

Those who have not regularized their enrollment in the terms and in the manner indicated above will be excluded from the Master. Those who have made false declarations will be excluded. The remaining places will be allocated to other candidates, in the order of final merit.

Failure to reach the minimum number of subscribers for the activation, the course will be revoked and total fees will be refunded.

ARTICLE 6 – Vacancies

Those eligible in the case of vacancies will be contacted by e-mail for enrollment, as specified in the preceding article, within a maximum of seven days from the day following to that of e-mail.

ARTICLE 7 – Class attendance

Class attendance is mandatory and the minimum requirements for Master title are:

- Frequency for a period of no less than 75% of the total duration of the in class lessons and experimental laboratory period of stages;
- Passing the final exam.



ARTICLE 8- Credits and title

The Course provides 15 credits as Art. 2, paragraph 5 of Postgraduate masters and courses Regulation. At the end of the course and after passing the final exam, the students will receive a certificate of attendance. The award of the title is subject to the correct payment of tuition and fees and any surcharges.

ARTICLE 9 – Privacy

The University Administration, in accordance with current legislation, is committed to use the personal data provided by the candidate only for the completion of the selection procedure and for institutional reasons.
